

Field Handwashing Station Options

This fact sheet is designed to provide the basics of what needs to be included in a handwashing station as well as some options for farmers to either purchase or build their own field handwashing stations. For all parts of a handwashing station <u>hands-free options are preferred.</u>

Five items to include in a field handwashing station:



 Fresh water that contains no generic E. coli



2. Soap



3. Container to catch waste water



4. Paper Towels



5. Trashcan with lid and liner



Don't forget the trashcan

These are a few considerations when procuring a trashcan:

- Need to contain trash with either a lid or by using an enclosed receptacle
- Need to have a liner
- Add rocks or sandbags in the bottom for weight
- Hands-free open/close is best
